If you would like your son to have Music lessons at Rosmini College in 2013, please fill out the form below and return it to school by Wednesday 30th January, 2013. (Please return this form and fees, as soon as possible in order to secure a space.)

The fee for students is \$200, which covers all the lessons for the year. The fee for NCEA students is \$100.

Rosmini College Music offers tuition on a wide range of instruments:

Woodwind: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone.

Brass: Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba, Horn.

Others: Vocal (singing), Drum, Percussion, Bass Guitar, Electric Guitar and Classical Guitar.

Students must have their own Guitar or Bass. The school will only supply these instruments for lessons, not for hire.

Lessons are during class times, half an hour per week and students will be taught in small groups. Lesson times will change each term, so that students will not always miss the same class.
